



Uniform Policy

- All students up to Year 5 in 2019 and all students up to Year 6 from 2020 onwards are expected to wear a Reporoa Primary School uniform.
- Students are expected to take pride in their uniform and wear it in a clean and tidy manner. It is to be worn at school, when travelling to and from school, and at school events when appropriate.
- Students wearing the Reporoa Primary School uniform or a Reporoa Primary School sports uniform are identifiable as belonging to the Reporoa Primary School community. It is therefore appropriate that students in either uniform adhere to the behavioural expectations of the school, even though they may not be on school grounds.
- The school logo is property of the Board of Trustees and cannot be screen printed or embroidered onto non-regulation clothing items purchased from an unauthorised supplier.
- The school policy on uniforms considers the Human Rights Act which forbids discrimination on the grounds of sex, religion or ethical belief, colour, race, ethnic or national origin, political belief, disability or age.
- Students who enrol during the year have 10 working days from the date of enrolment to purchase the uniform.
- The school will endeavour to assist students whose families have difficulty purchasing the correct uniform. This may be in the form of a letter to WINZ, passing on donated used uniforms or issuing footwear for the day.
- The uniform requirements will be published each year in the school Prospectus, in the school newsletter and on the school website.
- Students are free to combine items of the uniform to suit the weather conditions at the time, including footwear. There is no official summer and winter uniform.

Uniform:

Regulation Polo Shirt \$36 Compulsory Term One 2019

Short sleeve green regulation polo shirt with an embroidered logo. A plain black thermal can be worn underneath the Polo Shirt.

Regulation Polar Fleece \$42 Compulsory Term Two/Three 2019

Green regulation polar fleece with an embroidered logo.

Shorts Compulsory Term One 2019 (own provider)

These must be plain black shorts, with no unauthorised logos and can be purchased from any provider.

And/Or

Long Pants Compulsory (own provider)

These must be plain black pants, with no unauthorised logos and can be purchased from any provider.

And/Or

Skorts/Skirts Compulsory (own provider)

These must be plain black skorts or skirts, with no unauthorised logos and can be purchased from any provider. They may be worn with plain black tights.

Footwear (own provider)

Shoes are to be worn to and from school. Footwear must be flat soled black shoes; sneakers, slip-ons boots, sandals, jandals or gumboots. Plain black socks that are worn with closed in shoes are to be above the shoe line.

Regulation Hats \$16 Compulsory Term Four 2018/Term One 2019

Regulation black school bucket hats with logo are compulsory in Terms 1 & 4.

Jacket \$40 Optional (own provider or regulation)

Students are to wear any plain black jacket/raincoat/winter coat, with no unauthorised logos. The school green regulation jacket is also available for purchase at the NZ Uniforms. These need to be removed when inside classrooms.

Beanie \$x Optional (regulation only)

A black regulation beanie with school logo is available for purchase at NZ Uniforms. No other winter hats are permitted.

• Headwear/Hair/Jewellery

Hair must be clean, tidy and tied back if below shoulder length.

The only jewellery permitted is a single pair of small plain studs or sleepers, watch or item of personal cultural significance such as taonga, which must not present any danger or distraction to the wearer or any other child. They should not hang loose and must be worn inside clothing.

• Non-Regulation Clothing

Students are not permitted to wear non-regulation clothing items along with their compulsory uniform.

Naming

It is required that all uniform items are named. (This includes all footwear)

The regulation components of the uniform are to be purchased from NZ Uniforms, 1302 Ranolf Street, Rotorua. Generic black items and footwear are also available, or able to be purchased from <u>any supplier</u>.
